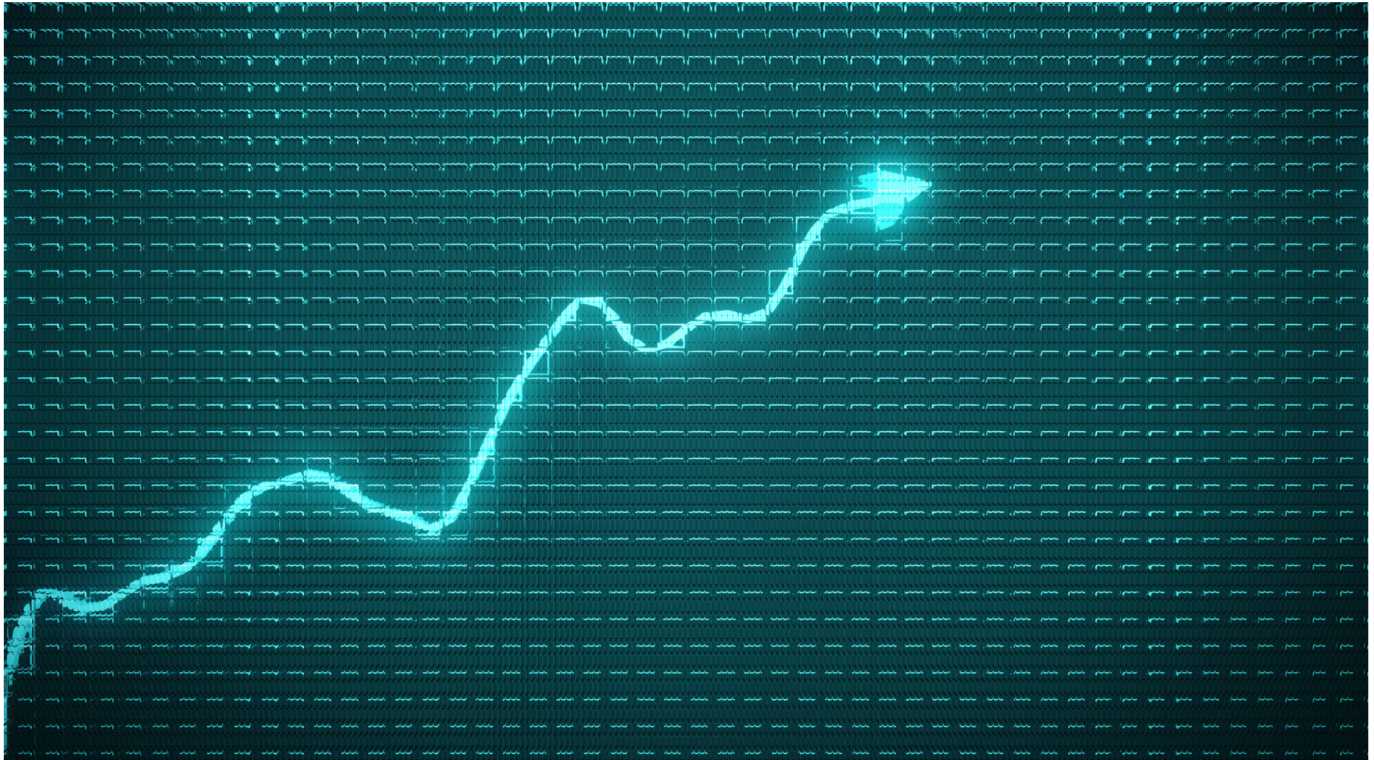

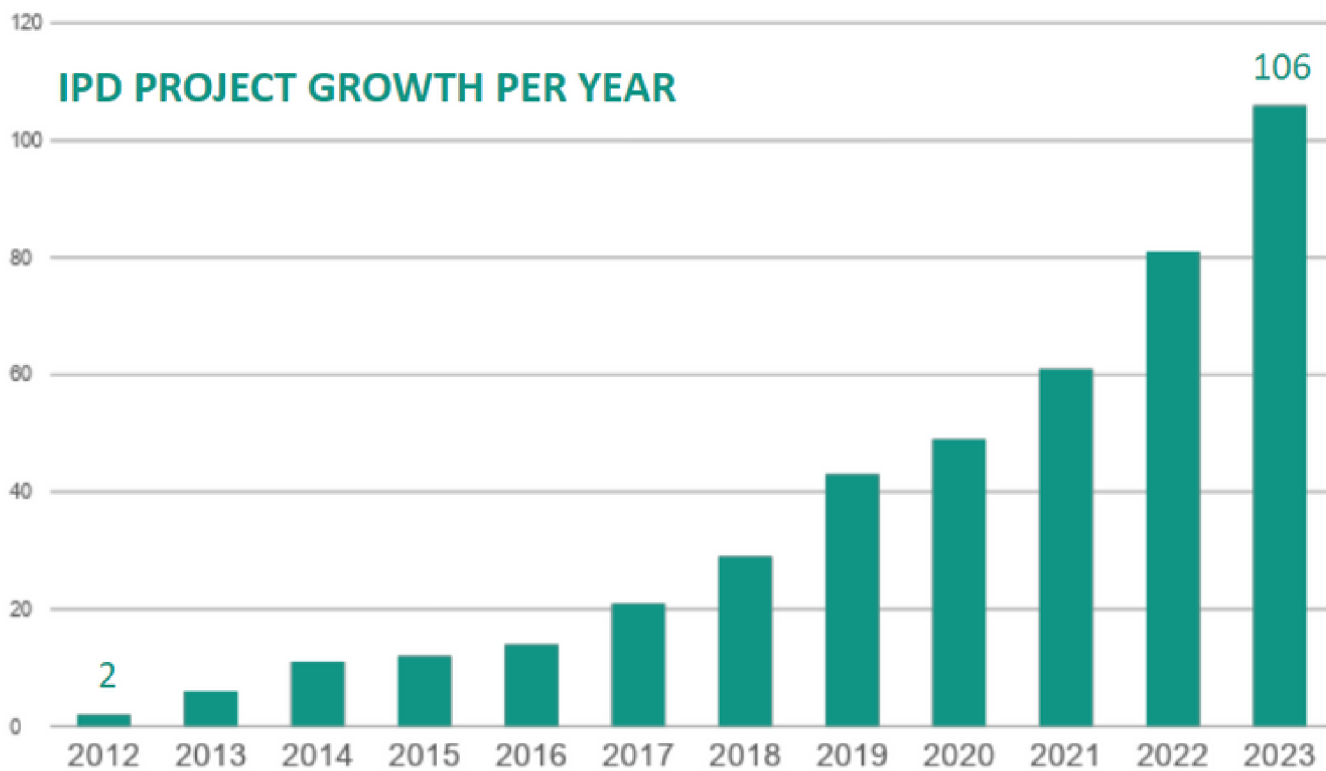


INTEGRATED PROJECT DELIVERY INDUSTRY SUMMARY 2023

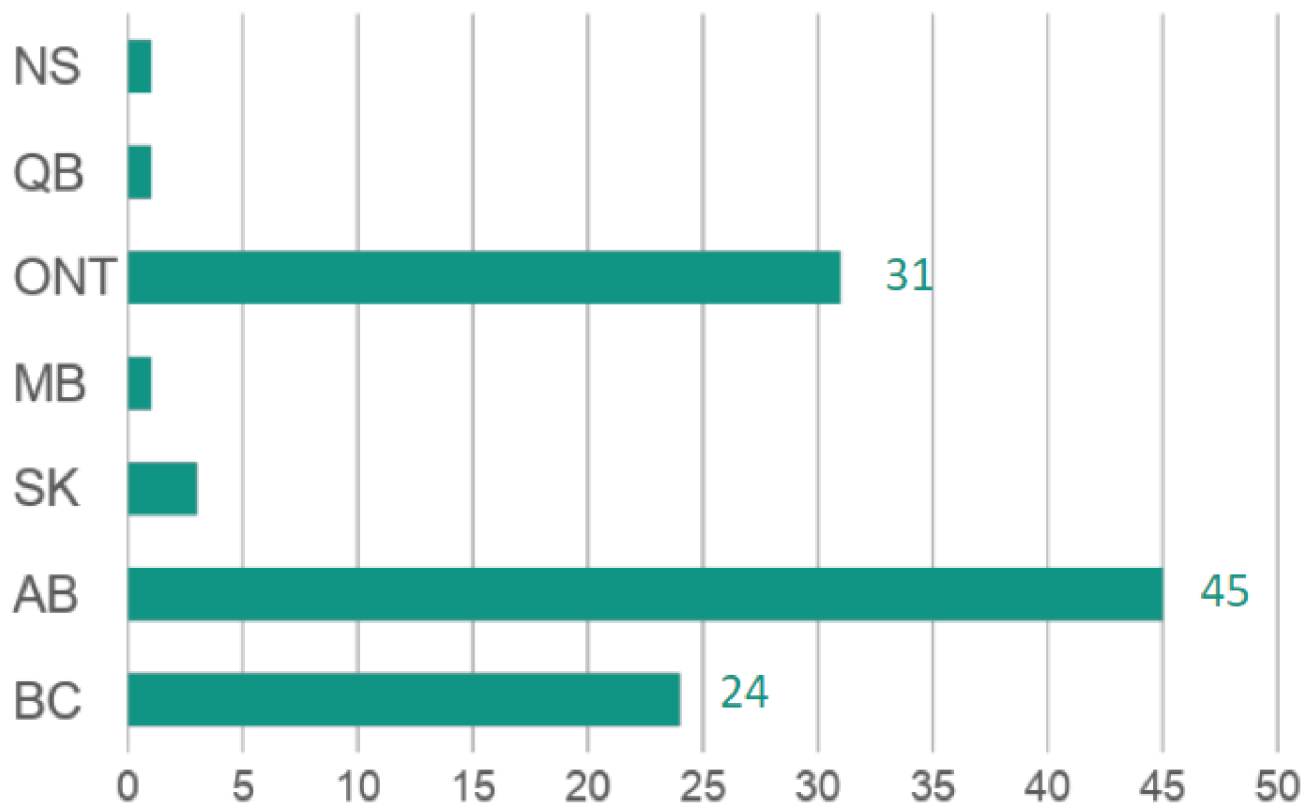

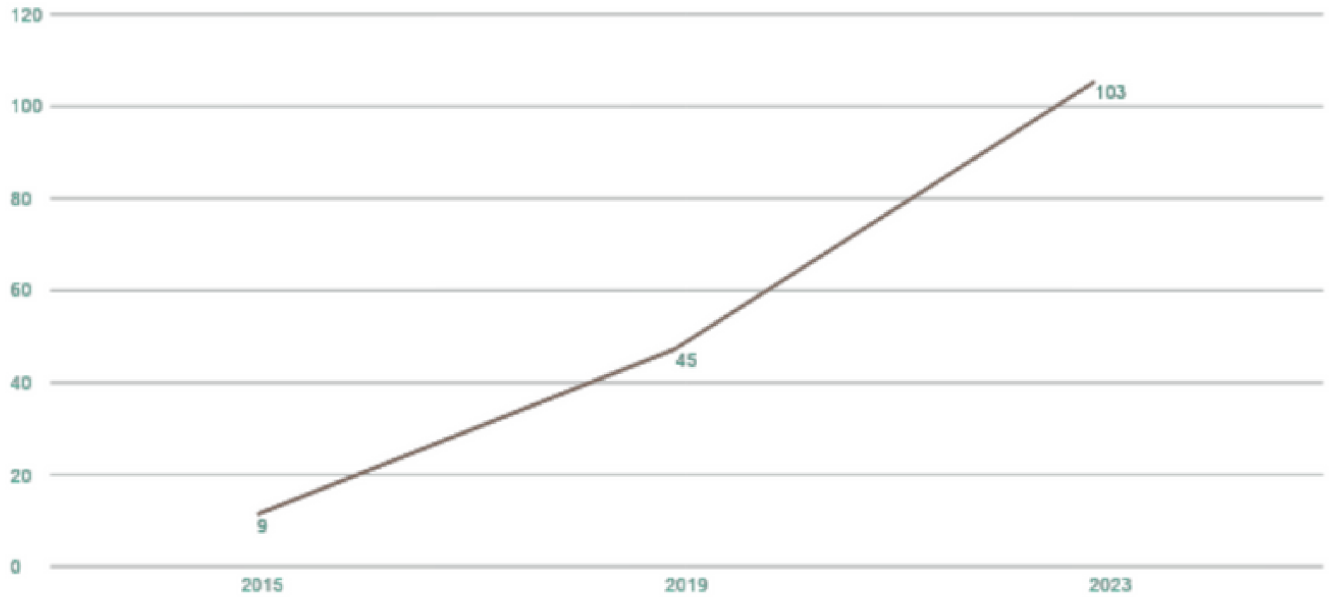


IPD PROJECT GROWTH
