NEW ONLINE FORUM FOR IPDA MEMBERS

First Session to be Held on THURSDAY, APRIL 30TH @ 1:00 PM MTN / 3:00 PM EST NO COST TO ATTEND

While travel and public gatherings are interrupted due to COVID-19 restrictions, the IPDA will begin to host a series of online meetings. For our first in the series, we will have two individuals share some tools that they have seen quickly implemented for their projects.

Dean Loewen of Altac Mechanical is currently working on the Okotoks Arts and Learning Campus IPD project with Al Williams of Mechwave Engineering. Al built a pull plan on Bluebeam Studio and, together with Dean, they will show how the pull plan session is able to be completed virtually. Dean will also discuss how important it has become for teams to connect to individuals on a personal basis as well in this time of added stress and pressures and it's impact on mental health.

Andrea Pelland of EcoAmmo will discuss challenges and opportunities in facilitating high performance project teams and workshops for major US institutions, as well as virtually facilitating pull plans for Edmonton Public Schools IPD projects.

The format will be an hour long on-line discussion group utilizing Zoom. Within that hour we will have 20 - 25 minutes hosted by individuals introducing interesting topics, half an hour discussion and Q & A.
