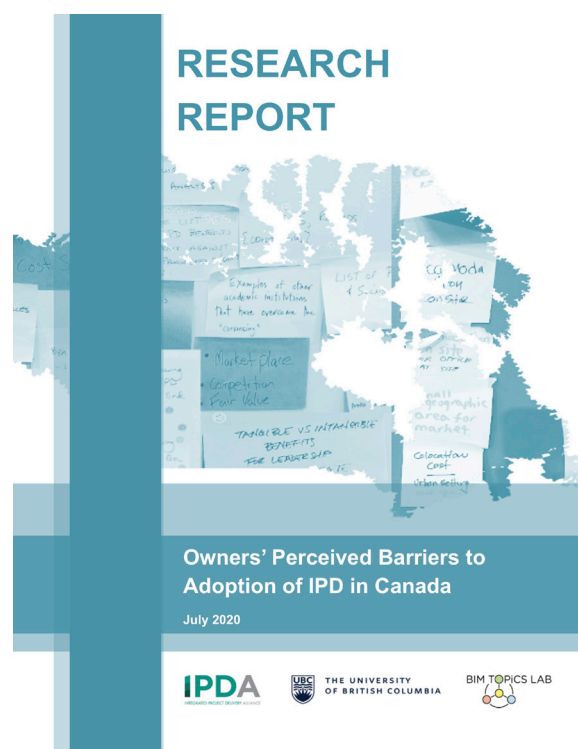

As promised in our last update, the latest research initiative sponsored by the IPDA and undertaken by the University of British Columbia, "Owners' Perceived Barriers to Adoption of IPD in Canada" is now available.

While IPD is emerging as a viable delivery model in the industry, with success stories from Canada and around the world, some Canadian owners are hesitant to give it a try. This study presents the research findings of a study investigating those owners' perceived barriers to adoption of IPD as a delivery model on their construction projects. The reasons are complex but can largely be distilled down to a set of six perceived barriers, explored in detail in this report.

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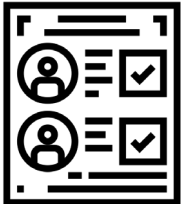
