IPD - WHAT GOES WRONG - CREDITS: OAA 3; 3.0 AAA STRUCTURED LH

IPD is a method of delivery that incentivizes continuous improvement. This session will explore challenges commonly experienced on IPD projects. After a short introduction, participants will engage in facilitated breakout sessions to discuss selected topics: (1) Procurement and contracts, (2) project controls, (3) co-location and validation, and (4) team culture. Each group will explore what goes wrong on IPD projects and strategies used to recover or correct these issues. A summary of the findings will be presented by a panel of facilitators to end the session linking the discussion and strategies to the various research and tools available to support IPD adoption in the industry. Participants will gain insight into the agility and flexibility of IPD and what strategies can help harness this for the benefit of your project.
