CANADIAN CANOE MUSEUM WORK IN PROGRESS UPDATE

In this month's edition of Touching Base, we are featuring an update on the progress of The Canadian Canoe Museum in Peterborough, Ontario which includes IPDA member companies Lett Architects Inc. LEA Group, and Chandos Construction.

The Canadian Canoe Museum was honoured as the recipient of a significant investment of \$750,000 to help create a new cultural and tourism destination on the Peterborough waterfront. This funding will contribute to developing a brand-new suite of professionally designed exhibits featured in our new museum's 20,000-square-foot Exhibition Hall. These exhibits will attract visitors from near and far to explore the canoe's significance to Canada through diverse themes, perspectives, and voices.

In July 2022 the museum welcomed the Honourable Helena Jaczek, Minister responsible for the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario, to the Museum where she announced over \$12.2 million for 33 tourism, community infrastructure, and economic development projects in Peterborough, Northumberland, and Kawartha Lakes.

The funding will help ensure that the Exhibition Hall meets Class "A" museum conservation standards, which allows The Canadian Canoe Museum to collaborate with other national and international museums and to develop unique new visitor experiences.

Visitors will also see and hear Indigenous languages and voices from the moment they enter the Museum, thanks to funding from TD Bank Group's Ready Commitment. The local Michi Saagig dialect of Anishnaabemowin will be used throughout the building and within exhibits alongside English and French, with additional Indigenous languages featured in relation to specific watercraft.

These exhibits will attract visitors from near and far to explore the canoe's significance to Canada through engaging exhibits, immersive storytelling, and hands-on learning.

Other team members include Engage Engineering, Lancer Electric, Kelson, D. G. Biddle & Associates, Basterfield & Associates Inc., and JHG Consulting Network Inc.

IPDA CASE STUDIES FEATURED ON LEAN IPD BLOG

Investigating Factors Leading to IPD Project Success in Canada is a new research report including three IPD case studies. The research presented in this report aimed to document three cases of IPD implementation in Canada to understand how and why IPD was implemented, if it was successful, and the reasons that led to this success or lack thereof. The case studies presented in this project are among the first documented cases of IPD implementation in the Canadian context.
