In this month's edition of Touching Base, we are featuring the OmniaBio B project for McMaster Innovation Park in Hamilton, Ontario. This ultra fast-track IPD project is the first component of the master-planned McMaster Innovation Park is being delivered by will be delivered by a team comprised of Colliers Project Leaders, IBI Group, Arup Canada, McCallum Sather, Guild Electric Limited, Sprint Mechanical Inc., Flynn Group of Companies, Walters Inc., and Multiplex.

Multiplex will deliver the core and shell as part of the project's first phase, which will span 119,000 square feet over three storeys. The IPD team has completed the validation phase, building permits have been submitted, and early works have commenced onsite.
